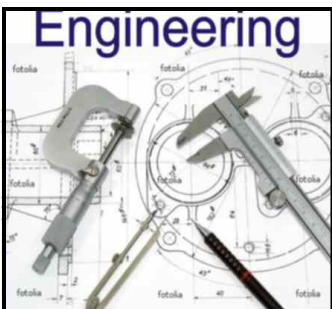

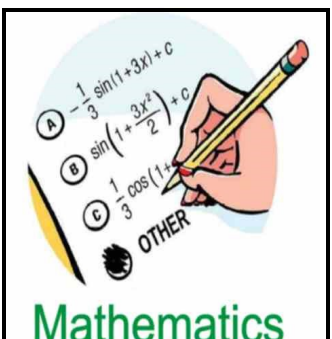
This workshop serves as the prerequisite for further MEEC STEM Service Learning workshops, including the STEM Certification program.
